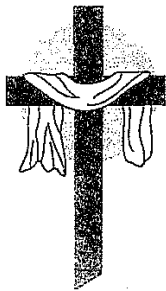


**March 6, 2016**

**Make an effort to refocus your mind throughout the day on thoughts of God and the joy of heavenly things.**

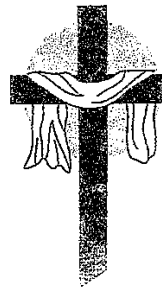


**March 7, 2016**

**Pray for the courage to surrender doubt and place your trust in God's Providence in your life.**

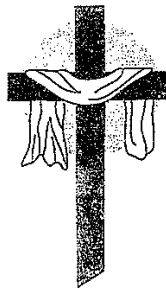


**March 8, 2016**  
**Tuesday of the Fourth Week of Lent**

Gospel Reading: Jn 5:1-16

*"One man was there who had been ill for thirty-eight years. Jesus said to him, 'Do you want to be well?'" (Jn 5:5-6)*

**Pay a visit to a sick or elderly friend or family member, and ask the Blessed Mother to intercede on their behalf.**



**March 9, 2016**  
**Wednesday of the Fourth Week of Lent**

Gospel Reading: Jn 5:17-30

*"Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes in the one who sent me has eternal life and will not come to condemnation, but has passed from death to life." (Jn 5:24)*

**Offer a Hail Mary for the Holy Souls in Purgatory while meditating on the gift of eternal life.**

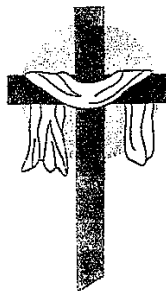


**March 10, 2016**  
**Thursday of the Fourth Week of Lent**

Gospel Reading: Jn 5:31-47

*"The works that the Father gave me to accomplish, these works that I perform testify on my behalf that the Father has sent me." (Jn 5:36)*

**Take time to prayerfully meditate on the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary.**



**March 11, 2016**  
**Friday of the Fourth Week of Lent**

Gospel Reading: Jn 7:1-2, 10, 25-30

*"So Jesus cried out in the temple area as he was teaching and said, 'You know me and also know where I am from. Yet I did not come on my own, but the one who sent me, whom you do not know, is true. I know him, because I am from him, and he sent me.'" (Jn 7:28-29)*

**Reflect on the suffering Jesus endured during His passion and death. Consider the love He must have for you, in order to have suffered so greatly on your behalf.**



**March 12, 2016**  
**Saturday of the Fourth Week of Lent**

Gospel Reading: Jn 7:40-53

*"Some in the crowd who heard these words said, 'This is truly the Prophet.'" (Jn 7:40)*

**Read a passage from the Old Testament or the Psalms today and pray for an increase of faith, hope, and charity.**
