God reminds us that what the Holy Spirit calls forth is sustained by the grace of God (John 14:26; Luke 3:16).

The Resurrected Christ is a Christ of creativity who participates daily in the creation of the universe (John 1:1-3). Courageous creation is what is needed in response to Christ's great commissioning to all of us in this time (John: 17).

Accompanied by the teachings of Pope Francis in Laudato Si': On Care for Our Common Home along with the Christian Mystics, spark your creative engagement with your faith and environment in the beauty of our natural landscape at Saint Anne's Shrine and other Vermont locations.


