

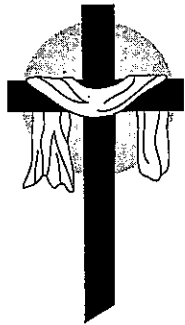
March 19, 2017

Pray for a true conversion of heart, so that you might turn permanently away from all that separates you from the love of God.



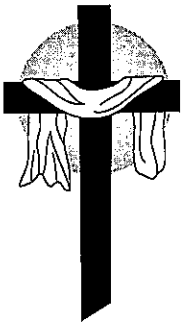
March 21, 2017

Show compassion today to a difficult or troubled person in your life.



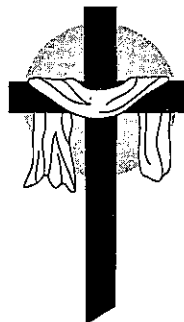

Make a humble petition to Our Lady, asking for an increase of vocations to the Priesthood, and greater unity within the Church.

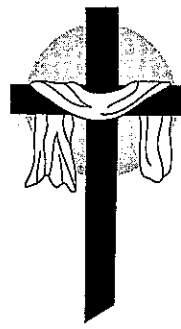


March 25, 2017

Pray the Angelus, thanking God for Mary's "Yes."



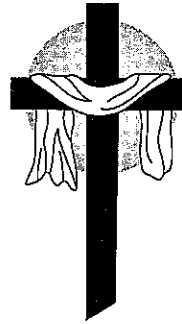
March 20, 2017

Gospel Reading: Mt 1:16, 18-21, 24a, or Lk 2:41-51a

*"Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her."
(Mt 1:20)*

Reflect on the trials endured by the guardian and earthly father of Jesus, asking Saint Joseph to teach you obedience and trust.



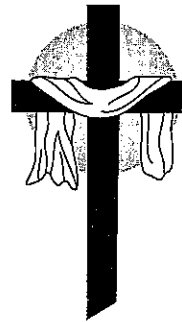
March 22, 2017

Gospel Reading: Mt 5:17-19
