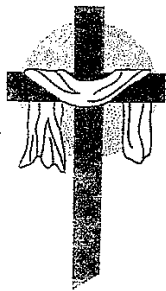


February 28, 2016

Resolve to practice patience in all your words and deeds, and to learn from the Lord Jesus in the Gospels.

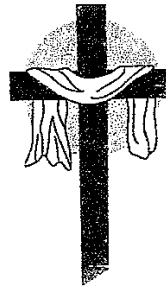


February 29, 2016

Pray that your belief and faith in Jesus Christ, our Savior, may be strengthened.

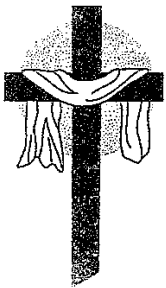


March 1, 2016

Show compassion today to a difficult or troubled person in your life.

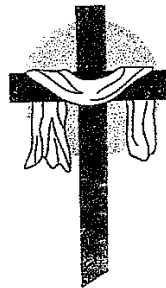


March 2, 2016

Gospel Reading: Mt 5:17-19

(Mt 5:19)

Set aside quiet time to meditate on each of the Ten Commandments and make a firm amendment to change a habit in your life that leads you to sin.

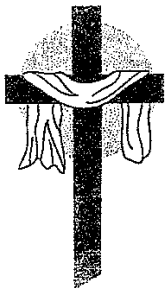


March 3, 2016

Friday of the Third Week of Lent

Gospel Reading: Mk 12:28-34

(Mk 12:31)

March 5, 2016
Saturday of the Third Week of Lent

Gospel Reading: Lk 18:9-14

"...for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."
